2. **Georg Friedrich Eduard HUTHSTEINER** "Edward" (Jacob) was born 25 Mar 1815 in Fruedenberg, Germany. He died 1862 in Cincinnati, Hamilton, OH.

Edward was a lawyer and a descendent of French Huguenots who fled from Nancy, France to Prussia during a time that Huguenots were being persecuted. Edward and Caroline, with their children, migrated from Siegen, Westphalia (Prussia/Germany) to the US around 1862 with Swiss colonization parties. They collectively founded the town, Tell City, Indiana, named after Wilhelm Tell. Tell City is located on the southern border of Indiana, in Perry County, bordering Kentucky.

Edward married **Marie Caroline ACHENBACH** "Caroline", daughter of Eobanus ACHENBACH and Anna Elisabeth ISING, on 12 May 1843 in Siegen, Westphalia, Prussia. Caroline was born 31 Mar 1822 in Siegen, Westphalia, Prussia and was christened 10 Apr 1822 in Siegen, Westphalia, Prussia.

Gustave migrated with his parents from Prussia to Cincinnati, OH., USA ~ 1862 and then proceeded to Tell City, IN. A couple years later where he married Pauline Carolyn Weber and resided around Tell City, Perry County, Indiana. After his 1st wife's death, Gustave had a 2nd marriage to Louisa Ludwig and had 5 more children. After Gustave died, his son, Robert Edward Huthsteiner, moved his step-mother, Louisa and her children to Schenectady, NY, where some of Robert's brothers had moved for employment opportunities with General Electric and American Automotive. Schenectady also offered a good college for the boys and a private school for Helen. This is how the Louisa Ludwig Huthsteiner side of the family became Easterners in NY. Later, Robert Edward Huthsteiner, returned to Indiana.

GUSTAVE HUTHSTEINER, REPRESENTATIVE FROM PERRY.

Mr. Huthsteiner is a native of Siegen, Prussia, where he was born April 17, 1844, but might be almost termed an American, since with his parents he came to Cincinnati, Ohio when only three years of age. In that city he was raised, educated in the free schools, and graduated with high honors at the Woodward High School, of Cincinnati, in June, 1861. He then commenced teaching in the public schools, but his adopted country needing his services he turned away from the schoolmaster's desk and entered the army as a private in the Fifth Ohio Cavalry. Returning afterward to the peaceful vocation he again pursued the profession of teaching for a while. In 1864 Mr. Huthsteiner removed to Tell City, Ind. where he became a prominent and influential citizen. He was elected Treasurer of Perry county for two successive terms Organized the National bank in Tell City and was for three years cashier of the same. The bank was then converted into a private bank of which he is now the manager.

Mr. Huthsteiner is married and has several little ones. He believes in the right of woman to enter into any field of labor of which she is capable, and Mrs. Huthsteiner therefore fills the responsible position of cashier of the bank, and during her husband's absence assumes its entire superintendence. Mr. Huthsteiner is also closely connected with the large manufacturing interests of Tell City. He is a liberal minded gentleman and a Democrat of the progressive order. Personally rather below the medium stature, he bears the distinguishing marks of cultivation and refinement; he has brown hair inclined to curl, a large expressive gray eye, clear complexion, broad brow and finely formed head, a genial and intelligent man who watches faithfully the best interests of his constituents.

HON. GUSTAVE HUTHSTEINER, cashier of Tell City Bank, is a native of Prussia, born April 17, 1844. He is the eldest of eight children born to the marriage of Edward Huthsteiner and Caroline Achenbach. The father who was a merchant, came with his family to the United States in 1848, and located in Cincinnati, where he died in 1862. His widow still resides in that city. Gustave received his education in the schools of Cincinnati, where he taught for two years. In 1864 he came to Tell City and was engaged in the drug business for a year, after which he again taught school until 1869. He then assumed the management of the Chair Maker's Union, and

continued in that position until 1871, when he was elected to the office of county treasurer, which he filled for two consecutive terms. In 1874 he was elected cashier of the Tell City Bank, and he still holds that position. During the session of 1879, he represented this county in the State Legislature, to which he was elected by the Democratic party in 1878. He served for three months during the Rebellion in Company K, Fifth Ohio Cavalry. November 26, 1864, he was united in marriage with Pauline Weber, who died December 25, 1883, leaving six children: Eugene G., Ella P., Edward E., Robert E., Alfred and Walter F. One child is deceased. Mr. Huthsteiner deserves great credit for the interest he has taken in building up the town and developing its manufactures.

Captain Huthsteiner will report at Governors Island upon his return from Germany and will remain here until the sailing of the first available army transport to San Francisco, Calif., aboard which he will sail for duty with the First Cavalry Division, Ft. Bliss, Texas.

Captain Huthsteiner, who served prior to the world war as an enlisted man in the Second Field Artillery, was appointed a second lieutenant of cavalry in June, 1917. Promoted immediately to first lieutenant, he became in two months more a captain.

He is a graduate of the troop officers' course in the Army Cavalry School at Ft. Riley, and also of the advanced equitation course.

Robert E. Huthsteiner Brewery opened in 1894 and closed in 1897 it was open for 3 years. Breweries that are only open for a couple of years like this did not have a long time to produce advertising and collectibles so they tend to be more scarce than breweries with more longevity. As a Pre-Prohibition Brewery, any advertising items or collectibles are likely to be valuable and desirable to collectors as they tend to be hard to find. Robert E. Huthsteiner Brewery was located in Tell City, IN, which only had 2 breweries, so there are not many that were producing breweriana items. Local collectors may pay a small premium over national or general collectors because of a lack of local items.

WALTER FUERST HUTHSTEINER. Bearing an old family name that is honorably identified with Tell City almost from the time of its beginning, Walter Fuerst Huthsteiner, banker, manufacturer, civil engineer and progressive, broad-minded citizen, is one of the outstanding business men of this section of the state. His interests are extensive and important and some of these, from their germination in Tell City's early village days, have expanded side by side with the city's growth.

Mr. Huthsteiner was born at Tell City, Perry County, Indiana, September 23, 1876, and is a son of Gustave and Paulina (Webber) Huthsteiner. His father, who was born in Germany, April 5, 1844, was brought to this country by his parents at an early age, the family settling at Cincinnati, Ohio. Gustave H. Huthsteiner was among the earliest residents at Tell City, where he arrived at the time of the Swiss colonization movement, the community being named in honor of the Swiss patriot, William Tell. Mr. Huthsteiner from modest beginnings rose through industry and keen judgment to be one of the leading citizens of his adopted place. He was one of the founders of the Tell City National Bank, in which he was a heavy stockholder, and was interested largely in a financial way in the insurance business. A man of great foresight and progressiveness, he was a leader in movements that assisted the little town to grow and prosper, and in his death, which occurred February 1, 1902, Tell City lost one of its most valuable and highly respected citizens. He married Paulina Webber, whose father, John Webber, was one of the early settlers of the Swiss community, and died in 1881. Six children were born to Mr. and Mrs. Huthsteiner: Eugene, deceased, who married Amalia Fricke, of Tell City; Ella, who married Charles F. Herrmann, the latter now deceased, and has five children; Edward, of Tell City, who married Dora Wittmer and has two children; Robert, who married Hedwig Duenwig, resides in El Paso, Texas, and has four children; Alfred, who married Dora Ahlf, resides at Pittsfield, Massachusetts, and has two children; and Walter Fuerst, of this review. The mother of these children, Mrs. Paulina (Webber) Huthsteiner, died December 25, 1883. In August, 1885, Gustave Huthsteiner married Louisa Ludwig. To this union were born five children: Hans, of Schenectady, New York, who is married and has two children; Gustave, of Cleveland, Ohio, has three children; George, a captain in the United States Army, is married but has no children; Louis, of Kingston, New York, has two children; and Helen, wife of Harry A. D. O'Connor, of New York City, has no children.

Walter F. Huthsteiner attended the public schools. Tell City at that time had no high school and, after finishing the work of the grades he attended the Weiley High School at Terre Haute for one year and had one year of work in Indiana State University. At this time he received an appointment to West Point Military Academy; but after one year left that institution and entered the Rose Polytechnic Institute at Terre Haute. Here he completed his work in civil engineering in 1901. During his years in the Rose Polytechnic, while he stood only a little more than average in his academic work, being on the honor roll once, he was especially active in extracurricular movements. He was captain of the football team, captain of the track team, president of the Athletic Association, president of the Indiana Intercollegiate Athletic Association, which included all the larger schools in the state, and president of his class and of the Student Council.

On leaving college Mr. Huthsteiner became an employee of the Tell City National

Bank, as assistant cashier, with which he has been identified for thirty years. He was made cashier upon the death of his father, and became president, an office he still holds, in January, 1919. In 1906 he became identified with the Tell City Furniture Company as president, and in 1924, upon the death of his brother, Eugene Huthsteiner, became active manager as well as president of the company, positions he still retains. In addition to the above he is president of the Tell City Creamery Company, president of the Knott Manufacturing Company, secretary and manager of the Tell City Canning Company and a member of the board of directors of the Citizens National Bank of Evansville. On January 1, 1931, he was elected a director of the Louisville branch of the Federal Reserve Bank of Saint Louis. He is also treasurer of the Tell City Hotel Company, operating one of the most popular hotels in Southern Indiana.

A friend of the public schools, he has done much to raise educational standards at Tell City as president of the local board of education. He served one term in the City Council, although he has never sought public office. Politically he is a Democrat. Fraternally Mr. Huthsteiner is a York Rite Mason, is a member of Hadi Temple of the Mystic Shrine at Evansville and also belongs to the Knights of Pythias. His religious connection is with the Episcopal Church. Mr. Huthsteiner is the foremost business man of the community, and has lived up to the splendid traditions of the family, the members of which have long been the backbone of the city's prosperity.

For an adequate picture of his character as a business man and citizen. some other items showing his unselfish service to the community should be noted. During the World war he served as chairman of the Liberty Loan organization of the county. Much of the population of the county was strongly pro-German in character. There was only a weekly paper for publicity, with poor roads to facilitate meetings in the county, and under these circumstances it is highly creditable to the energy and understanding of the committee that each quota assigned was over subscribed, so that an indispensable service was rendered to the nation at that time. The record of the committee still remains unrecognized by any of the usual patriotic memorials given to those who served their country in time of need.

Mr. Huthsteiner also served as a director of the Tell City Chamber of Commerce for twenty years, and for two years was its president. In this connection he has been very active in efforts to secure new industries. He has also fathered the good roads movement in Perry County for over twenty years, and his part in this work has made his name known throughout the state.

Mr. Huthsteiner married Miss Edna L. Clark, whose father, Charles R. Clark, was a pioneer settler and pottery manufacturer of Cannelton, Indiana. To their marriage were born two children. Dorothea, who lives at Tell City, and Walter Clark Huthsteiner, who was graduated from the Staunton Military Academy at Staunton, Virginia, in the class of 1931. He had the honor of being fourteenth cadet in military rank in a corps of over 500 boys, holding the rank of lieutenant.

'Up the Mountain Road' book about Brother Louis - b. October 4, 1892 is probably incorrect.

Louis' family resided on a mountain called 'The Eagles Nest' in the Catskill mountains, near Hurley, NY. In his mid life, Louis lost interest as a lawyer and dedicated his life to Christianity and Evangelism. He wrote an unpublished autobiography which included details of his grand father's migration from Prussia to the US. He also wrote of his childhood years, college years, army years, his conversion to a devoted to Christian and later experiences. Hope Stanton Lee and her husband Harold met Louis in his later years and became very dear friends and fellow Christians. Hope was inspired to write a photo illustrated biography of 'Brother Louis' detailing his later years when she knew him and his ventures as an evangelist. Her book was called 'Up the Mountain Road'. Her husband had a few bound copies published. Unfortunately the book was not archived with a major

publishing company, so it is not possible to have more of them published.
